The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance recited. There were no guests present. Supervisor Frank Polovich was not present at the meeting.

APRIL 13, 2011 REGULAR MEETING.

A motion made by Loxley and seconded by Summers was passed unanimously to approve the April 13, 2011 Regular Meeting minutes.

AMENDED MARCH TREASURER'S REPORT AND APRIL TREASURER'S REPORT.

A motion made by Summers and seconded by Loxley was passed unanimously to approve the amended March Treasurer's Report and April Treasurer's Report.

ROADMASTER REPORT.

Bob Summers, Roadmaster, said, the Roadcrew has been working on two areas on T373 Watson Farm Road. He said they have graded T358, Beaver Meadows Road, T371, Job Corps Road and T374, Sheffield Junction Road. He said they filled potholes on T327, Duhring Road, and the beginning of T371, Job Corps Road. Summers reported the Supervisors had an executive session on May 5th for personnel matters. Summers said he met with Doug Carlson to discuss installing a geocell system near the timber bridge in Brookston. He said this could be funded with Dirt and Gravel Roads grant money. He said he would want the Engineer involved and will be calling him to discuss his cost to help.

CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT.

Marjorie Villarreal, Code Enforcement Officer, said Road Agreements and permits were signed with Shell Corporation (SWEPI LP) for their use of over-weight vehicles on T374 Sheffield Junction Road, T333 Bean Farm Road and T372 Fork Run Road for one year. She said Kane Hardwood was permitted for three months to use T358 Beaver Meadows Road. Villarreal and the Supervisors discussed a building permit and possible sewage violation on SR 1005, Watson Farm Road.

ADVERTISE TOWNSHIP CLEAN UP.

A motion made by Summers and seconded by Loxley was passed unanimously to advertise the Township Clean Up in the Forest Press and the Valley Voice.

LETTER TO JEFFERSON PAVING.

A motion made by Summers and seconded by Loxley was passed unanimously to send a letter to Jefferson Paving Corporation asking them to repair T327 Duhring Road.

SHEFFIELD TOWNSHIP FIRE AGREEMENT.

A motion made by Summers and seconded by Loxley was passed unanimously to sign and pay \$3500.00 to Sheffield Township for the Sheffield Volunteer Fire Department Agreement.

WATSON FARM ROAD PIPELINE DISCUSSION.

The Supervisors and Secretary discussed writing a letter to Verizon to start a dialog with them about lowering the pipeline on T373, Watson Farm Road.

BILLS TO PAY.

A motion made by Loxley and seconded by Summers was passed unanimously to pay the bills.
