The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance recited. Guests present were Kimberly C. Fultz, representative for Suit-Kote Corporation.

MAY 13, 2015 REGULAR MEETING.

A motion made by Summers and seconded by Shaffer was passed unanimously to approve the May 13, 2015 Regular Meeting minutes.

MAY TREASURER'S REPORT.

A motion made by Summers and seconded by Shaffer was passed unanimously to approve the May Treasurer's Report.

ROADMASTER REPORT.

Bob Summers, Roadmaster, said they have finished the drains on the T327, Duhring Road project. He said they have done mowing and on the berms getting the road ready for the triple seal coat. He said all of the roads have been lightly graded. Summers said they have graded Greeley Farm Road for Jenks Township in exchange for the help their roadcrew gave them with installing the drains on T327, Duhring Road. He said they will continue to keep up with the mowing on the townships roads. He said this month they had to replace a leaking gas tank on the International truck.

CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT.

Marjorie Villarreal, Code Enforcement Officer, said she permitted over weight vehicles for Kane Hardwood for three month permits to use their vehicles on T358, Beaver Meadows Road. She said she received a municipal building permit application from John Zemko on Blue Jay Creek Road to build a 6' x 28' roof addition to their porch at their seasonal camp. She said the Tobolewski's applied to build a 8' x 21' addition to their camp on Route 666. A motion made by Polovich and seconded by Shaffer was passed unanimously to approve the building permits.

PENNDOT AGILITY AGREEMENT AND RESOLUTION 15-2.

A motion made by Summers and seconded Polovich was passed unanimously to adopt PENNDOT Agility Agreement and Resolution 15-2.

BILLS TO PAY.

A motion made by Shaffer and seconded by Summers was passed unanimously to pay the bills.

HIGHWAY SUPPLIES.

Suit-Kote employee Futlz returned to the meeting and the sealed bids were opened. A motion made by Summers and seconded by Polovich was passed unanimously to approve to purchase the low bids in highway supplies all from Jefferson Paving Corporation of 500 ton of limestone DSA for \$29.14 per ton totaling \$14,570.00, 400 ton #8 anti-skid for \$31.49 per ton totaling \$12,596.00 and 100 ton of 2B limestone for \$28.38 per ton totaling \$2838.00 with all delivered to the garage by June 30, 2015 and 10,000 square yards for T327 of Triple Bituminous Seal Coat for \$3.79 per square totaling \$37,900.00 applied by June 30, 2015. Other bids were Glenn O. Hawbaker bid \$32.04 per ton for 500 ton of limestone DSA for totaling \$16,020.00, \$35.04 per ton for 400 ton #8 anti-skid totaling \$14,016.00 and \$30.54 per ton for 100 ton of 2B limestone totaling \$3054.00. Suit-Kote Corporation bid \$4.67 per square for 10,000 square yards for T327 of Triple Bituminous Seal Coat totaling \$46,700.00 and for the same Russell Standard Corporation bid \$3.868 per square totaling \$38,680.00.

A motion made by Shaffer and seconded by Polovich was passed unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 1:35 PM.
